PROGRAMS

Male Mentorship Program

In view of the positive role models in our community, this program is designed to provide educational, social, and domestic skills necessary to have a positive impact on our community. Our goal is to empower and assist the male in developing and demonstrating responsible behavior.

Objective 1 – Decrease the number of negative school related behaviors (i.e. gang violence, fighting, disrespecting parents)

Objective 2 - Enhance academic performance

Objective 3 - Improve Social Skills and Peer Relationship

Boys-To-Men (Rites of Passage)

This enhancement program is designed to honor the men in our community by identifying their role, purpose and destiny.

Role – We address the past, present and future of the men in our society; giving them a clear definition of their positive and negative influence to their community; strongly encouraging directives to change their thinking and attitudes to better their environment.

Purpose – Many of our men are looking for their place in society. During this session we identify from a historical perspective, the role of males and compare our present surroundings that can either distract or influence us in fulfilling our purpose in life.

Destiny - During this workshop the participants are challenged to become active in the discussions to assist them in finding solution to issues that are presented. It is our intent for the men to take on their responsibility as men and to develop into mature role models in their community.

Engaging Fathers & Significant Males in Service

This workshop is designed for parents, community employees who work with fathers and trainers who “engage fathers into male service. During this session the role of male-fatherhood will be identified and challenged. Participants actively participate in designing tools and resources that will encourage, re-direct, and influence positive male-fathering.

Some of the topics include:

- Understand the issues of “fatherlessness”
- Identifying the needs and barriers of fathers
- Identifying community resources for fathers
- Methods utilized to engage participation of fathers
- Identifying best practices to services fathers
